Scholarship Use: The NPA Scholarship must be used at a two or four-year accredited college or university or an accredited trade school. The scholarship recipient has until June 2020 to use the funds. Applicants must be entered as matriculated students pursuing further education in horticulture, botany, landscape design, landscape architecture or environmental science. Funds may only be used for tuition and books. Funds are paid directly to the school that the recipient will be attending. Scholarship winners also receive a 1-year membership in the NPA.

Selection Criteria: All applicants will be evaluated on:

- 1. Transcripts from most recent school attended
- 2. Application including letters of recommendation

- 4. All applicants must be a U.S. citizen or a Permanent Resident residing in the Puget Sound region.
- 5. All applications are the property of Northwest Perennial Alliance and will not be returned.
- 6. All applicants will be notified by August 1, 2019 of the Scholarship Committee's decision.
